

Band Project Purchase Report

Background: When the Itoe administration came to power in May of 2015, one of the items of its action plan was to stay away from embarking on new long-term infrastructural projects in Sasse such as the sickbay project. The administration therefore looked for ways to directly impact the lives of the students on campus without necessarily putting a strain on Soba America's coffers. One of the ways that this could be achieved was to use the office of the President as a tool to promote goodwill towards the students of Sasse by engaging Sobans, Sobanese and possibly non-Sobans worldwide.

After a series of visits to Sasse by President Emeritus Itoe and some members of the NLT between 2015 and 2017, and after consultations with stakeholders, PE Itoe decided to yield to the students' concerns and pushed for a new band and orchestra for S.J.C Sasse. Potential donors (Sobans and Sobanese) worldwide were contacted on a one-on-one basis to solicit pledges and donations for this project. It was done this way in order not to force anyone or chapter who did not share the vision to donate and to make sure it will be done only with funds raised for this project. The administration's timeline of the project and vision was shared with potential donors. A WhatsApp fundraising group with about 43 Sobans and Sobanese potential donors was created to spearhead this effort.

Timeline: Fundraising started in early 2018 and had to be completed by September 2018. Purchase of all relevant equipment was scheduled to be done and shipped to Cameroon before the end of the year. However, the search for the right equipment and a request for more time by some donors

to fulfil their pledges led to the extension of the deadlines set by leadership. While purchases started at the beginning of 2019, research on band and orchestra equipment started in October 2018 with the review of several options on the market. It was during this process that we opted to buy used top-notch professional uniforms, hats and accessories.

Equipment Purchase: An update on the band project and equipment purchased in early 2019 were published in our 2019 SOBA America magazine. Research and selection of equipment were done by Sobans who were involved in our previous band donation over 20 years ago and by some Sobans with professional music experience.
