Other costs covered, include the Soban suit and tie and Soban flag and shield used at the funeral for our fallen brother. - 9. Payment made for upcoming 2020 convention including the Mariott Hotel, park and final payment for convention 2019 security
- 10. Payment made to DJ Elmo for DJ services provided at the 2019 national convention
- 11. Payments made to Abenity for Soban discount program
- 12. Payments for operational expenses including Neon CRM, Grasshopper, Quickbooks, and square cash for legal and professional services
- 13. Wedding benefit paid to Soban Ako Nana to help celebrate his big day
