

### President Fote's message - March 2022

Fellow SOBANS,

Greetings. I hope you had a great month of February, and I hope you and your family are staying safe from the COVID-19 pandemic. I just want to take a few minutes and bring you up to speed with what has been happening at SOBA America this past month, and upcoming March plans.

#### **2022 National Convention COVID-19 precautions**



strictly enforce this mandate.

As we continue to prepare for the 2022 National Convention coming up this Memorial Day weekend, we are closely following the COVID-19 pandemic situation. We will do all we can to make our convention as safe as possible for SOBANS and their families and guests. We are monitoring the CDC guidelines and we will follow them. Here are some key elements of our COVID-19 safety plan for the convention.

(1) Vaccine Mandate: We require all delegates and guests at the convention to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19. When you go to get your convention credentials, you will be asked to attest that you are fully vaccinated and are willing to show proof of your vaccination status. You will need to e-mail the proof of your vaccination status (copy of your vaccination card) to organizingsec@sobamerica.org by May 20th. Please do so as soon as possible, so we can get everything in place to ensure that you have a smooth and remarkable experience at the convention. Please note that we will

(2) Cashless Convention: We will not accept cash at our convention. We will have multiple options for electronic payment. In addition to reducing likely hood of transmission of COVID-19 through cash changing hands, this change will help improve efficiency, accountability and transparency with our financial management.

(3) Masks: We will closely monitor CDC guidelines and follow them. From a public health perspective, mask wearing has been proven to be an effective tool in the prevention of the spread of disease. On February 25th,

the CDC released new county specific mask recommendations for counties across the US based on a number of factors including new cases, hospitalizations, and hospital occupancy rates. Based on that the CDC recommended no indoor mask wearing for Dallas County. As you know, conditions may change leading to changes in recommendations. We will monitor closely and either mandate mask wearing or highly recommend mask wearing, depending on the CDC's recommendations during the convention weekend.

(4) Temperature checks: We will do temperature checks at different points during the convention.

(5) Hand sanitization: We will ensure that there are adequate hand sanitization stations available. We will also take appropriate steps to ensure proper safety measures with food service.
